


For a few weeks now, we publish the results of the samples of our growers. They were asked to take one sample per 250T potatoes - and one sample per 125T for the variety Innovator - while loading the barn.

Our quality department checked these samples on underwater weight, size and defects. The defects (in amount of points) include shocks, damages, wireworms, as well as green, hollow, or rotten tubers.

This week we present the summary of the results for the main varieties (2011-2013). For details you can go back to the previous presentations. You will also find a few results coming from our factory in Germany (2012-2013).



#### NL - Tuber size






### NL - Tuber count – tubers/kg






### **NL - Underwater weight**






### **NL - Quality - points**






#### **Germany – Tuber size**
